If you use the Docman Desktop Application for scanning make sure that you refresh the folder list to show the new 'Not in a folder' group.

This release contains the following new features:

TFS ID	Description of change
27247	System Optimisation. We've improved the way that we store configuration settings to enable password reset functionality.
27945	We've removed the 'All documents' group in capture and filing so that documents are only listed once in the folder that they are added to. Where documents are added and a folder is not specified they are grouped into the 'Not in a folder' group.
27950	The usual GP assigned to a patient is now shown on the patient banner. Where no usual GP has been assigned, the label is not displayed.
28071	Lists of clinical codes that are shown in pre-defined list options in a clinical coding task and in settings have been sorted in alphabetical order.
28072	It's now possible to search for a term ID in addition to a term description in the term browser. Searches must be pre-fixed with a full stop to initiate a search using the term ID.
28075	System Maintenance. We've increased the data we capture from the Docman Desktop Application for auditing purposes.
28078	Roles have been removed as one of the values available to create a workflow view.
28079	We've reformatted the way that the clinical coding detail is shown on the clinical coding activity panel. Bold has been applied to the term description, bold styling has been removed from the term ID and we've moved the position of the description to be above the term ID.
28080	In Docman Desktop Application settings underneath the Clinical System heading we've introduced a setting for users to choose if Docman is minimised when using the 'View in EMIS' action.
28082	The name of the user that added content into capture and filing is now shown as one of the labels in the document list.
28083	It's now possible for users to set their preference for the level of zoom applied to a document preview. This can be set in Settings, My Profile, Document Viewer Settings, Document Zoom Mode. This will preserve the zoom setting wherever a document preview is shown.
28157	Back office records have been sorted to show the most recently added records first.

28158	We've added the ability for users to choose which folder electronic documents are delivered into in the capture and filing area. This is configurable by the Docman Support team.
28166	Auto-preview was available in one of the first versions of Docman 10. Now, with the introduction of the docx and pdf viewer the setting is redundant and has been removed.
28168	The icon used to initiate 'Show related tasks' has changed because it was being confused with the 'User' icon.
28463	System Optimisation.
28517	We've altered the way that total number of tasks is shown. The total is shown next to the task icon on the notification and navigation bar. Once in an inbox or view the number of tasks displayed is shown next to the total number e.g. 200 of 600 at the top of the panel. More tasks can be shown by selecting the 'show more tasks' action at the bottom of the task list.
28525	An extra label has been added into the document list in Document Viewer. In Primary Care, this label is 'Department' but this could differ in Secondary Care settings if customers have defined their own fields.
