Whenever a user wishes to access an inactive patient they will have to submit a reason why. A notification will then be sent to the privacy officer notifying them of this.

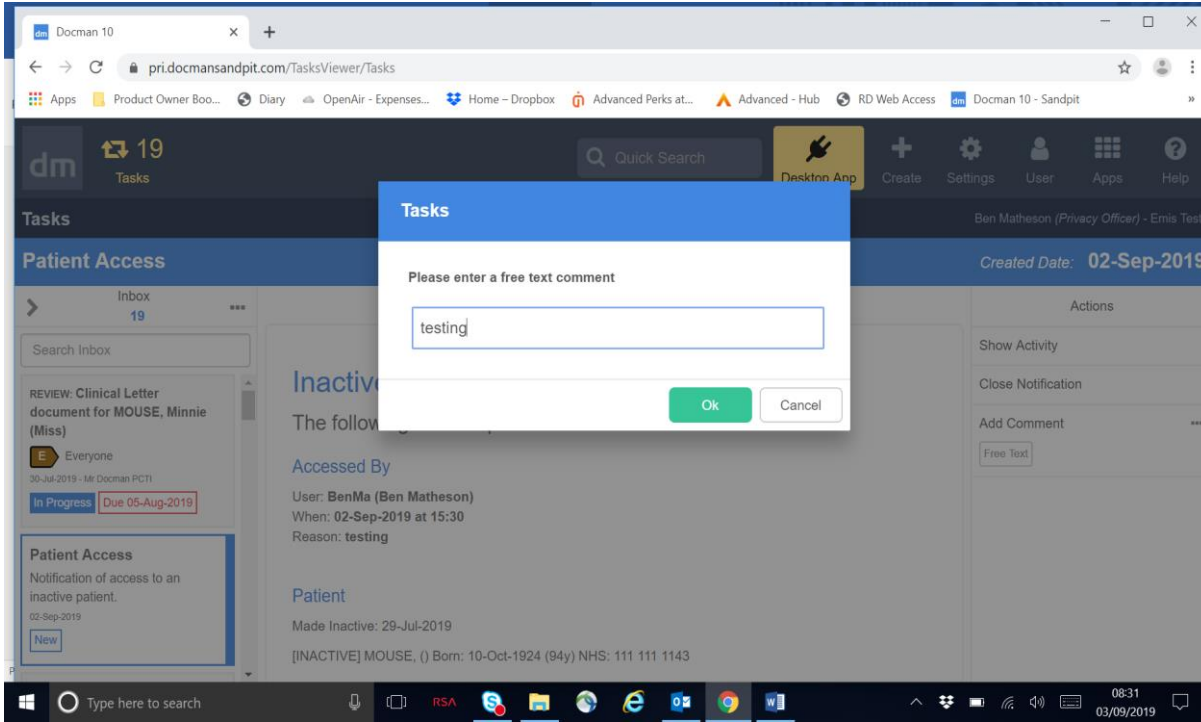
