# **API Changes**

This release contains the following API specific changes:

DCMC-503	Internal	Defect	136 HOTFIX   Connect SOAP API EDT_AddDocumentXML uses wrong CaptureSource & Legacy metadata not populated	When adding a document to connect via the SOAP Web Service, the CaptureSource was originally set to API (100). This should have been set to Hub (2) so that the Accept/Reject buttons were enabled in DM10. This change has now been made and the accept/rejection functionality is now present in DM10 for Connect SOAP documents.  In the Connect inbound model, there is a field named "LecgacyMetadata" which is used to store EDT Hub metadata. A change has also been made so that the metadata sent via the SOAP service is now captured in the "LecgacyMetadata" field.

DCMC-380	N/A	Bug	PCTI user document list page when status is system error, Actions section is breaking (UI)	A bug was found under PCTI users, when filtering the documents list page by system errors, the actions section became misaligned. This only happened on certain resolutions however a fix is now in place to stop this misaligned issue.
DCMC-470	Internal	Defect	136 HOTFIX   Contributor is not mapping to Person in Connect	When sending via the Connect SOAP service, the "Contributor" that is sent via the SOAP xml was not mapping to the Connect "Person" field. A change has now been made which maps the contributor and person fields. This data can also be found in the document list export.
DCMC-486	Internal	Defect	Connect Console - Memory issues	An issue was found internally by Squad 2 where the Connect console was causing the server to run out of memory. A previous fix had already been applied which related to Aspose.PDF. Further investigation has now taken place and we have identified another part of Connect that uses the PDF conversion. This is when a document is uploaded via the capture console, and sent to a TPP site, it needs to be re-converted to PDF. This conversion is now performed using a separate app domain and should mitigate this issue.
DCMC-491	N/A	Story	Add "Destination Org Name" to document list export	A change has been made to the document list export and the practice name can now be found upon release of Connect 139.
DCMC-497	Internal	Defect	136 HOTFIX   Document list export   misaligned data when comma added	When sending via the Connect SOAP service, if a comma was added to the "Contributor", when exporting the documents list, the data was misaligned making it difficult to read. A fix has now been applied which stops this from happening.

This can be found on sending organisations only.
DCMC-428	N/A	New Feature	SQS - Connectbot to ignore documents with Workflow Engine flag set to true	An amendment has been made to the Connectbots related to DCMC-427 (ticket above).
DCMC-401	N/A	Task	Creation of DCMC Regression test case suite	Placeholder for regression test case creation.
DCMC-398	N/A	Bug	On premise Updater - Missing org issue	When an OOA collection needed an update but the source org didn't exist, it caused Connectbot to error and a backlog of documents. This no longer happens and instead the document is updated to update source error and proceeds as normal through Connectbot without causing an errors or backlog.
DCMC-499	21913908	Defect	136 HOTFIX   Patient ID is not matching	An issue was identified when viewing some documents on the Connect console, the physical file and metadata did not match. This was caused by an outdated cache file which needed updating after a note was added. This fix has now been applied and this issue will no longer occur when adding notes to documents.
