| DEDT-159 | DFCT0011044 | Defect | EMIS PCS Summariser: Unable to amend the significance of Read Codes | An issue was found when using Summariser to Read Code into EMIS PC, when on the clinical filing details screen, the option to amend the significance was greyed out. A fix has now been applied, allowing users to amend the significance if required. |
| DEDT-432 | N/A | Bug | Recipient roles Application closes without description | When creating and saving a new role, a pop-up box appears asking to enter a description. When clicking 'OK' to the message the page would close without a description being present. This no longer occurs, and users will now be required to enter a role description before the role is saved. |
| DEDT-454 | N/A | Bug | Application crashing in library section | When using the 'Select Section' option on the Document Viewer screen and users selected 'Library', the application would crash forcing the user to close Docman. This no longer occurs, and the Library will now open when selected by the user. |
| DEDT-526 | 21814100 | Defect | Document been rejected on DM7 scheduler as bad file name | When scheduler collected documents for the site, if any documents contained '/' in the description, an untrapped error would be logged and the document would be rejected. This was due to the description being used as the files name, file names cannot contain certain characters. If scheduler receives any documents containing special characters, these will now be replaced with '_ '. |
| DEDT-385 | 21688859 | Defect | Docman site is remaining offline after the Docman Backup has completed | An issue was found with the Docman backup, once the backup had complete, sites were remaining offline. This was caused by a web message crashing which was taking place before the site was switched back on. A change has now been made so that the web message functionality takes place after the site is brought back online. |
| DEDT-541 | N/A | Task | Investigation Docman AppCrash | Investigation into application crashes on site. After checking WMI (Windows Management Instrumentation), a number of invalid classes |

| DEDT-549 | N/A | Task | Zepher test cases | Placeholder for test case creation. |
| DEDT-185 | DFCT0011169 | Defect | Patient Sync issues SBAB (Dual Site) | An issue was identified with the Docman patient sync. When running a patient sync, site 1 patients were syncing into the second site's database in a dual/multi-site setup. This was caused by the first site's database being used to check if all sites were shutdown before a backup. A change has now been so when the backup process checks for the shutdown time for the backup, the database of the site running the backup will be used. |
| DEDT-527 | N/A | Bug | Manual Patient Sync Issue on Multi Sites | When running a manual patient sync on either site setup as a dual/multi-site, the patients were not updating correctly with the details from the clinical system. This links to DEDT-185 and the same fix applied to this reference also resolved this particular bug. |
