Email Notification to User on Password Change

Internal reference DCMC-3678

Description

When a user password is changed, either by the user or by their Administrator, a notification will be sent to the user. This is for security reasons to ensure that the user's password is not changed without their knowledge.

New Email – User Initiated Password Change

When a user changes their own password, they will receive an email stating “Your account password has recently been changed, if you did not make this change please contact your local Administrator for support.”

Existing Email – Local Administrator Initiated Password Change

The current email which is sent to users when the local Administrator initiates a password change will now include the additional text “If you did not request this password reset, please contact your local Administrator for support.”

(the email currently states “Your account password has recently been reset, please use your email address/username with this temporary password: nnnnnnnnnn”).

Defect Fixes



Bad File Name on DM7 Scheduler

Internal reference DCMC-2854

Problem

Documents are being rejected from Connect - Docman 7 scheduler error message with error "bad file name". This blocks the scheduler from running, until manual action is taken. This is caused when the <Enter> button is pressed within the description field.

Resolution

Any line feed character is removed from the description field when downloading.



Connect API Rejecting Documents for Endpoints with 12 Digit ODS Code

Internal reference DCMC-3775

Problem

Documents are being rejected from Connect API if the endpoint has a 12 digit ODS code.

Current Issues



File Size "bloating" post Conversion

Internal reference DCMC-3480

Problem

Docman Connect currently uses Aspose.Word and Aspose.PDF as part of the document conversion process. Issues around file size bloating have been reported by numerous customers and internal staff and Aspose have acknowledged there is an issue with file size bloating. The team are investigating another conversion tool which can either fully or partially replace Aspose
