#### **Scotland SCI Gateway Changes**

## D10-11807: When no 'active' flag is in the request default behaviour is to return only ACTIVE Patients

Problem: There is no requirement to be able to search for documents against an inactive patient or to file documents to an inactive patient.

Solution: Inactive patients should not be retrievable via the API, or if they are, they should by default be excluded from searches except when explicitly asked for

- GetDocumentReference
- GetPatient

# D10-11808: Patients Query with above max count should return up to the allowed maximum count and not an exception

Problem: A patient query with \_count=100 returns an error "Count must be between 1 and 50". Solution: Return all patients without error up to maximum allowed

# D10-11858: GetDocumentReference - using type = {Empty GUID} or type = "missing:true" should only return documents not in a folder

Problem: When running GetDocumentReference using a type of "missing:true" or "{Empty Guid}" the results contain all documents for all folders.

Solution: Return documents "Not in a folder"

#### D10-11860: GetDocumentReference - Folder Descriptions are missing in response

Problem: When running GetDocumentReference the response where the Folder Id is returned is returning a blank Description

Solution: If the Document is "Not in a Folder", the description will state "Not in a Folder"

D10-11877: 502 Bad Gateway on Post Document reference call

D10-11879: Post document reference call - Accepting content type "text/plain"

#### D10-11897: Patient Address Line Issue

Problem: Formatting of patient address in API is incorrect

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# Scotland Auto Filing Fix - Post Document Reference call not filing to the patient

Internal reference D10-11752

Problem: Using the Post Document Reference call and the documents are going to the filing queue and not the patient record

Solution: a) Where it is NOT AutoFile then an Accepted (202) should be returned WITHOUT any location header b) Where it is AutoFile then an Create (201) should be returned WITH a location header.
